Dear Mr. Wooten

On 4-24-2012, Wes Hare and William Burke, representing the State of North Carolina, Division of Waste Management Solid Waste Section, inspected the above referenced facility for compliance with North Carolina solid waste statues and rules. The following violations were noted:

- A) 15A NCAC 13B .0838 (10) states [*Disposal area boundaries shall be clearly marked on the ground while a site or any portion of a site is in use.*] Disposal area boundaries were not clearly marked, there were no markers for application present.**
- B) 15A NCAC 13B .0838 (7) [*Septage shall be applied to the surface of the land from a moving vehicle in such a manner as to have no standing liquid or soil disturbance resulting from the waste flow after the discharge is complete.*] Areas of ponding, run off, and large sections of "lime crust" where observed in fields 1 and 2.**
