The NC Division of Waste Management has closed out permit, **SLAS-74-10**, issued to you for the operation of a septage land application site in Pitt County off of Hwy 222. The Division is closing this permit based on your closure notice received on November 2, 2010 and the last inspection conducted on August 11, 2010. **Remember that land application of septage on sites that are not permitted can result in administrative penalties of up to \$15,000 per violation per day in accordance with NC General Statute 130A-22.** If you have any questions in this matter, please do not hesitate to call me at (919) 707-8283.
