**FINAL WARNING**

RE: Compliance with Notice of Violation (NOV)

Dear Mr. Mashburn:

This is to notify you that Alexander County Landfill (permit # 02-01) continues to be in violation of water quality monitoring requirements. The Notice of Violation issued on September 18, 1997 (attachment 1) required the Alexander County landfill to comply with the actions listed below:

- \* sample the landfill monitoring wells and analyze samples for the Appendix II list of constituents;
- \* provide a statistical analyses of previous monitoring well data;
- \* submit ground-water flow rate and direction determinations.

The Notice of Violation required that this information be submitted by November 25, 1997 (60 days from receipt). I received a letter dated October 15, 1997 signed by Mr. Wayne Sullivan of Municipal Engineering (attachment 2) promising the requested information within this time frame.

To date the Solid Waste Section has received only:

- \* the Appendix II monitoring results from the December 3, 1997 sampling event at the Alexander County Landfill
- \* groundwater flow rate and direction determinations.

This information was received on February 19, 1998 (almost 3 months past the deadline given in the Notice of Violation). The Section still has not received the required
