RE: Final Hydrogeologic Review Of The Transition Plan For The  
Alexander County MSW Landfill (Permit # 02-01)

With the revisions to the Transition Plan for the Alexander County Landfill submitted by Municipal Engineering and GAI dated May 5, 1995; January 29, 1996; April 19, 1996; and May 17, 1996, the Local Area Study and Water Quality Monitoring Plan are generally satisfactory. Therefore based upon the hydrogeologic review, the Alexander County Landfill Transition Plan can be approved.

I am still somewhat confused on the existing permitted facility boundaries. Hopefully, the most recent submittal of Enclosure 1, Operation Plan - Monitoring Well Locations, (updated 5-3-96) accurately portrays the current facility boundaries.

It should be noted that approval of the Transition Plan does not include approval of the sampling reports. These documents are subject to separate review by Mark Poindexter and Larry Rose of our Groundwater Compliance Unit.
