RE: Proposed Horizontal Expansion, Ashe County Sanitary Landfill,
Permit No. 05-01.

Dear Mr. Dixon:

This letter is in response to your request for clarification concerning buffer requirements for the proposed horizontal expansion of the referenced landfill.

The Solid Waste Section has determined that the required buffer distances are as follows:


- (1) A minimum 100' buffer between the existing landfilled area and the proposed disposal area
- (2) A minimum 300' buffer between the proposed disposal area on the western property boundary
- (3) A minimum 500' buffer between the residences and the proposed disposal area on the eastern property boundary
- (4) A minimum 50' buffer between the proposed disposal area and the present northern property boundary contingent upon purchase of the adjacent property

In addition, the proposed construction plans must incorporate the design of a liner and leachate collection system. The design of the proposed piping of the small stream in the middle of the expansion area must also be addressed in the construction plans.
