Jaclynne, On another note, were there any pesticides in the groundwater monitoring at the landfill, and were there wells installed on the west side of Newland highway about 2 miles south of Newland for monitoring. Also, Who in the department regulates pesticides in soil and groundwater and what are the soil cleanup standards. I am using groundwater criteria for comparrison but the only soil values I can find are in the solid waste area for unrestricted landuse. Any guidance you can provide would be greatly appreciated. Here is some information provided by Jaclynne Drummond, Compliance Hydrogeologist in the Raleigh office:

There are three landfills located in Avery County in Newland:

- 1) 06-01 Closed .0500 MSW (closed 1995)
- 2) 06-02T Transfer Station
- 3) 06-03 C&D .0500

06-01 Latest Monitoring Results (Benzene greater than 2L Groundwater Standard (= 1 ppb), other constituents are detections only)

- \* MW-1  
Benzene (1.3), 1,4-DCB, 1,1-DCA, cDCE, lead
- \* MW-3  
Benzene (1.7), 1,4-DCB, cDCE, lead

06-03 Latest Monitoring Results

- \* CMW-3 (all detections, not exceedances)  
CFC-11 (not greater than 2L Groundwater Standard), chromium, lead

Consistent results with mostly detections from both landfills fl rom each semiannual sampling event.

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
