The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Request for Modified Sampling Frequency for Certain Wells* dated October 2, 2015 (DIN 25120) and submitted on behalf of Republic Services, Inc. by Jett Environmental Consulting for the Charlotte Motor Speedway MSW Landfill V, Solid Waste Permit Number 13-04. The landfill entered the Assessment Monitoring Program in accordance with 15A NCAC 13B .1634 in 2005.

Republic Services, Inc. is requesting that groundwater monitoring wells MW-17, MW-17A, and MW-24 be sampled annually instead of semiannually because they are located too close to waste and no longer function as proper point of compliance wells. In addition, groundwater monitoring wells MW-33 and MW-34 are located downgradient of these groundwater monitoring wells. The next scheduled sampling event for these groundwater monitoring wells would be in April 2016.

As a result, the request is approved at this time. Please also continue to follow the October 23, 2014 approval letter regarding the Appendix II monitoring request (DIN 22116).
