On June 4, 2015 the Division of Waste Management (Division), Solid Waste Section received your letter entitled;

Request to Permit Waste for Disposal, Marshall Steam Station Operational Landfills (Permit No. 1809-INDUS and 1812-INDUS, Catawba County, North Carolina. Prepared by Duke Energy. June 2015. DIN 24465.

The letter requests authorization to dispose of coal combustion residuals (CCR) from other Duke Energy Corporation facilities, specifically the Riverbend Steam Station, into the two (2) active landfills located at the Marshall Steam Station, permit Nos. 1809 and 1812.

The Division has reviewed the request and hereby authorizes the disposal of CCR from other Duke Energy Corporation facilities at the two (2) active landfills at the Marshall Steam Station, in addition to the currently permitted disposal activities. Furthermore, the Division authorizes Duke Energy Corporation to immediately utilize the two (2) landfills located at the Marshall Steam Station for the disposal of CCR from Duke Energy Corporation facilities. The two (2) active landfills at the Marshall Steam Station are authorized to operate in this manner until permit Nos. 1809 and 1812 have been modified to reflect this change.

Lastly, the letter referenced above (DIN 24465) is considered a permit modification request, and Duke Energy Corporation will be invoiced accordingly.
