On October 19, 2015 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Duke Energy's notification and request letter for the FGD Landfill (Facility) located at the Marshall Steam Station in Catawba County, entitled:

Industrial Landfill Status and Variance Request, Permit No.: 1809-INDUS (FGD Landfill), Marshall Steam Station, Catawba County, Terrell, North Carolina 28682. Prepared by Duke Energy Carolinas. October 2015. DIN 24154.

The Section appreciates the Facility's formal notification of discontinuance of waste placement at the landfill and approves its request to defer closure activities as specified in the approved plans (DIN 20177). The Section's expectations are the Facility will;

1. Apply a minimum of one foot (12 inches) of intermediate soil cover to all areas of the landfill;
2. Within six (6) months utilize temporary seeding to stabilize all areas of the landfill;
3. Notify the Section when each activity(above) is completed;
4. Notify the Section of the Facility's determination, whether to expand the landfill or enter into closure, by October 1, 2016;
5. And prior to implementing final closure the Facility will submit, for Section approval, a revised closure plan.
