They also operate compost facilities in VA; Berkley County, SC; and Ireland. In Feb. 2012, an employee of Smithfield hog processing plant died while draining sludge into a McGill truck, and there was a lawsuit attempting to place responsibility with McGill (I don't know the final outcome)– news articles Dec. 2013</u>
