Dear Mr. Bean:

This letter is in response to your letter delivered to me on March 16, 2015 whereby an extension for meeting the conditions for compliance of the Notice of Violation for your facility was requested by you until May 1, 2015. The Notice of Violation noted failure to follow the requirements of the regulations noted in 15A NCAC 13B .0542, the approved operations plan and the permit to operate for your facility.

The original date to bring the site into compliance was March 19, 2015. Based on conversations with facility staff concerning the quick actions taken to stop and repair the leachate release point once it was detected and the fact that there has been quite a bit of inclement weather as you pointed out in your letter, the request for an extension until May 1, 2015 to bring the facility into compliance with the regulations, permit to operate and the approved operations plan is granted. A follow up inspection shall occur on or around May 1, 2015 to confirm that work has been completed to bring the site into compliance with the regulations, operations plan and permit to operate.

It should be noted that any changes or modifications to the permitted facility or approved operations plan should be submitted to the permitting branch for discussion and approval before changes or modifications are made and initiated.

Please be advised that if the facility is not brought into compliance by May 1, 2015, a notice of continuing violations may be issued to notify you that compliance actions to include civil penalties may be initiated. Also, it should be noted that additional days of penalty can be added as days of non-compliance in a civil action. Your continued cooperation in this matter is greatly appreciated.
