Dear Mr. Howard:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Operate for the Wilkes Road Yard Waste Facility, Permit No. 2610-COMPOST. This permit issuance approves the upgrade of the permit from a treatment and processing facility to a compost facility.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate requirements which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations. Please review the conditions of the permit carefully.

Of particular note are site specific conditions #9, 10, 11, 12, and 19 on pages 4 and 5, which concern use of the landfill cover for storage of wood material, reducing pile sizes, installation of boundary markers, and meeting required buffers.

Storage of wood material on top of the LCID landfill could be approved because the operation would not interfere with any groundwater monitoring around the landfill area.
