

## Updated Operation Plan

We recycle construction and demolition debris waste. We accept block concrete, asphalt, wood, sheetrock, insulation, siding, metal, plastic, cardboard, yard debris, ductwork piping, carpet and other construction debris originating from a construction or demolition site. We Estimate 25 tons per day.

We accept recycling debris from the following counties: Cumberland, Harnett, Hoke, Robeson and Sampson.

We dispose of the waste that we collect in each county back to that county's landfill. The recyclable items are disposed of at the following areas:

We have a fence entrance that has an electric gate. The gate is controlled by office personnel and we also have cameras monitoring the property. Our road is dirt and gravel which is maintained at all times. We are open 7:30 AM to 5PM Monday through Friday.

We have a sign posted on the main gate and have directional signs to the scales and then the dump area. The proper numbers to call are clearly posted.

A certified transfer station operations specialist is on site at all times during hours of operation to assist and answer any questions our handlers may have should the need arise.

We operate the facility by weighing in all debris on our in house scales, logging where it came from. Then proceed to the unloading area where they will dump the waste then leave the premises.

In June 2011, AAA Hauling of NC installed a conveyerized picking line with a trommel machine to streamline the recycling of C&D debris. In 2012, AAA was awarded a grant to obtain a skid steer and increase the size of our tipping pad. As granted, we turned the "picking machine" around and put the working pad at the top of the hill, still staying inside our permitted 190'x225' area. We increased the pad size towards the picking machine to keep the recyclable products and concrete on the pad and off the dirt.

We no longer store clean concrete long term but dispose to the Cumberland County Solid Waste facility on Ann St. in Fayetteville on a regular basis. We are not storing clean dimensional lumber long term at this time but disposing to Cumberland County Solid Waste on Wilkes Road for their recycling of wood mulch.

With great disappointment, at the beginning of 2013 we have taken the trommel offline. We found that the screening of "fines" is not beneficial as we cannot use them and the landfill does not want. We work from our large tipping pad and using man power and our skid steer to place recyclables in 30 yard containers designated for each recyclable produced (plastic, cardboard, paper, metal, wood, brick, concrete and C&D) to go to the landfill or prospective recycling facility.

All paint, rebar and waste are removed prior to disposing of concrete, brick and asphalt. All waste is removed prior to disposing of land clearing debris and clean wood. Recyclable materials are removed once a week or sooner if the containers are full. If storage of recyclables is required, they are covered daily. We do not store materials on our pad.

We do not receive any household waste or any unacceptable waste on our site and we police the area daily to keep it clean and free of trash. At the end of each day the pad is swept clean. We do not see any reason for recyclables to remain on our yard for 1 year.

We do not operate in the rain at this time and we are using speedy dry to absorb any liquids that are on the tipping pad and will continue to do this in the future.

We have fire extinguishers located throughout the facility. If we have a fire, we will call 911 and assist with our fire extinguishers as needed.

We have a record log to track daily incoming and outgoing tonnages. Our employees inspect each load as they come in. The log reflects the type of waste received. The out-going recyclables and waste is weighed as it leaves the yard. We keep track of where the waste originates from and dispose of it to the proper facility.

If our equipment breaks down, we do not accept C&D waste, yard debris, wood, concrete, brick or asphalt until the proper repairs are made. If a spill is detected, we take all necessary measures to clean it up as soon as possible. We are on a dead end road and have no traffic problems. We do not operate in extreme weather conditions.


