Mr. Hardin:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed a review a request for a five-year renewal of the Permit for the AAA Hauling of NC Inc. Transfer Station (DIN 23087). The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on January 23, 2015.

Based on this review, there are several recommendations we would like to make prior to completing the Permit renewal activity. Please let me know if you intend to revise any of you plans based on the following recommendations:

1. Based on our records, the Site Plan has not been updated since 2010. We recommend you submit revised Site Plan drawings if any changes have been made at the facility since that time.
2. It is my understanding you have expressed an interest in constructing a pole barn on site. If this is the case, we recommend you revise the appropriate plans and resubmit now to avoid having to pay another permitting activity fee in the future.
3. Conditions of the Permit to Operate require an individual trained and certified in facility operations to be on-site at all times during operating hours. We recommend, at a minimum, the individual(s) directly involved with the day-to-day handling and management of waste be trained and certified.
