Hi Drew,

Based upon the TCLP analyses provided, there are three metals that exceed the NC 2L Standards.

- Sample K5B0873-01 has an exceedance of Chromium (0.0186 mg/L with a standard of 0.010 mg/L);
- Sample K5B0873-02 has an exceedance of Cadmium (0.00220 mg/L with a standard of 0.002 mg/L); and
- Sample K5B0873-02 has an exceedance of Selenium (0.0310 mg/L with a standard of 0.020 mg/L).

It appears that this material should go to a permitted landfill and does not meet unrestricted use.
