Yard Waste Area

1. A contractor was onsite grinding the stockpile of yard waste and clean wood during this inspection.
2. There were several windrows of ground material on site.
3. I recommend some of the clean mulch be used on the closed MSWLF to assist with soil stabilization and seeding operations as you fill in the drainage ditches in lieu of disposal.

Concrete Stockpile/Crushing Area

4. Concrete continues to be collected in the stockpile area.
5. Concrete crushing was taking place at the time of this inspection.
6. According to staff they have received additional funding to continue to crush concrete to reduce the stockpile.
7. The side slopes need mowing in order to perform inspections of the landfill to ensure the integrity of the cover.
