The referenced **PERMIT TO OPERATE** is issued in accordance with N.C.G.S. 130A-294 and the N.C. Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B.


This **PERMIT TO OPERATE** is for a five-year period for Cell 1 and the scrap tire monofill, consistent with the final contours shown on Drawing 2 (Site Plan) of the approved plans. At the end of this five-year period, Dare County may apply for an expansion but will be subject to all rules in effect at that time. This **PERMIT TO OPERATE** is issued to Dare County as the owner and operator of the facility.

Please refer to the **GENERAL** Conditions of the permit issued on 14 March 1995 for recordation procedures, the definition of the approved plan, and for general terms of the Solid Waste Permit. The **CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION** conditions describe permitted fill areas, acceptable waste types, landfill operation, and requirements which must be satisfied prior to operation of the facility as a Construction/Demolition landfill and Scrap Tire Processing/Scrap Tire Monofill. Specific requirements for groundwater monitoring and facility record keeping and reporting are described in the **MONITORING AND REPORTING** conditions.



Dear Mr. Coffey:

AWT is writing on behalf of Dare County to certify that, to the best of our knowledge, the referenced permitted facility has been completed in substantial accordance with the approved plans and specifications. These facilities include a construction/demolition (C/D) landfill pad, tire monofill pad, tire collection and processing area, borrow pit, and access roads.

The C/D landfill pad and tire monofill pad fill have been installed to a minimum depth of five (5) feet above the existing grade and will provide the required four (4) feet of separation between waste and groundwater. Although the vegetative cover has not been established, this is not a structural component.

The groundwater monitoring wells have been installed and samples have been taken and analyzed to determine the quality of groundwater prior to disposal of waste at the facility.

On behalf of Dare County, AWT hereby requests approval for disposal of waste at the C/D landfill and tire monofill.
