Dear Mr. Lacsamana:

The Solid Waste Section has completed a review of the *Request for Reduction and Recycling Center* dated September 23, 2015 (DIN 25108) and submitted on behalf of Waste Management of Carolinas, Inc. by Joyce Engineering for the Piedmont Landfill and Recycling Center, Solid Waste Permit Number 34-06. This landfill has been closed since 2004.

Waste Management of Carolinas, Inc. is requesting the following regarding monitoring requirements at the landfill:

- Remove groundwater monitoring well MW-6 from the routine compliance monitoring network. There are currently two background groundwater monitoring wells for this landfill. It is proposed that this groundwater monitoring well may or may not be abandoned.
- Remove deep groundwater monitoring wells MW4D, MW11D, and MW-12D from the routine compliance monitoring network. It is proposed not to abandon these groundwater monitoring wells at this time.
- Reduce the frequency of routine groundwater and surface water monitoring from semiannual to annual.

As a result, the requests are approved as described as long as groundwater conditions remain stable and with one exception. Groundwater monitoring well MW-6 should not be abandoned at this time.
