The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received a request for a five-year renewal of the Permit to Operate at the Graham County Transfer Station (DIN 21195). The document was submitted on your behalf by Ms. Kim Crisp and was received in the Asheville Regional Office on June 4, 2014.

The submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee has been paid and all the components required by 15A NCAC 13B. 0401 have been submitted so the application is deemed **complete**.

Based on this renewal request, the Section has reviewed the currently approved plans for the facility. It has been determined the approved plans still meet the regulatory requirements. As a result, no further information is required and an amended Permit to Operate will follow in the future under separate cover.
