1. The Camp Butner LCID is only used for land clearing and inert debris that comes from Camp Butner. The Camp is comprised of several contiguous parcels of land and it is the training site for the NC National Guard.
2. Visible, permanent markers were observed showing the limits of the edge of waste.
3. There were no unacceptable items observed at the site- Very good.
4. The site has a good soil cover and a good ground cover established.
5. The site appears to be very well run.
