Dear Mr. LaRue:

As explained in Paragraph J of "Exhibit A-Statement of Work," the NC Division of Waste Management (DWM) is to participate in a certification of completion inspection once the remedy at the Seaboard Chemical site has been constructed and is operational. The Responsible Parties would then submit a Construction Completion Report after DWM agrees that the construction of the remedial system has been performed in accordance with the requirements of the "Statement of Work."

DWM is requesting that the Responsible Parties submit a draft of the Construction Completion Report prior to the certification of completion inspection. Due to the number and extent of remedial system design modifications, DWM believes a draft Construction Completion Report should aid in determining whether the current remediation system compares favorably with design expectations. DWM and the Responsible Parties will then continue with the sequence of requirements contained in Paragraph J of the "Statement of Work." DWM believes this request does not materially change the scope of work outlined in the "Statement of Work."
