I want to thank you for meeting with us on January 22, 2015 regarding the City of Greensboro's request for a MSW landfill permit amendment. The meeting was in response to your initial review of the City's application for the White Street landfill permit amendment (41-12). Based on our meeting discussion, I wanted to follow up and propose the following process regarding the City's permit amendment application.

The City submitted a request for a permit that would have a term of 10 years and for an annual tonnage of greater than 100,000 tons. The City is agreeable to reducing the requested term of the permit to 5 years. To more closely match the current and foreseeable future operations, the City also agrees to reduce the annual tonnage from greater than 100,000 tons to less than 100,000 tons. We appreciate the explanation staff of the Solid Waste Section provided on this issue and hope that these revised parameters more closely fit the permitting requirements.

In addition to the above change of request, we will also provide verification of local government approval of our request. Our staff will work through our Solid Waste Management Commission, City Council and City Attorney over the next 60 days in order to provide a letter from the City Attorney outlining the conditions of use and acceptable materials of the White Street Phase III landfill (permit # 41-12).

The City appreciates the opportunity to work with you on clarifying any documentation regarding the landfill. As evidenced by recent Division audits and environmental reports (groundwater and landfill gas), the operation of the landfill is protective of the environment and complies with the operational requirements of the Division. I look forward to receiving a completeness review letter from you so that we can proceed with the technical modifications that were also mentioned during our meeting.
