General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may also be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. The site is a medical waste treatment and processing facility.
2. A Permit to Operate was issued on March 25, 2014 and a pre-operative inspection was conducted on April 10, 2014.
3. Medical waste treatment is conducted by an Ozone process.
4. The Operations Plan states the pre-profiled medical waste is received, scanned and x-ray before being processed. The medical waste is shredded and hydraulically transferred to the sealed treatment chamber for disinfection with concentrated Ozone gas for 20 minutes. The treated medical waste is to be loaded into leak proof contains for shipment and disposal.
5. Upon the initial trial run for the treatment of medical waste a problem was encountered with the shredder, and medical waste treatment operations have been suspended until new shredding technology becomes available.
6. The facility has transferred incoming medical waste to Stericycle for incineration.
7. The facility is now not processing or receiving medical waste.
8. Currently there is no medical waste on site, and the facility has been thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.
9. Mr. McQueen is to contact the Solid Waste Section upon change of status for the facility.
