ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

On September 16, 2015, John Patrone met with Robert Fryar to conduct a comprehensive inspection of the Fryar Grading and Hauling, Inc. LCID Landfill on McLeansville Road in McLeansville, Guilford County.

1. The facility is a land clearing and inert debris (LCID) landfill.
2. The facility is in operation Monday through Friday 7:30 am to 5:00 pm.
3. The facility is operating in Phase 2.
4. The facility is permitted to receive waste generated within Guilford County.
5. The facility is permitted to receive land clearing waste, yard trash, untreated and unpainted wood, uncontaminated soil, inert debris, and (used) asphalt.
6. Per 15A NCAC 13B .0566(3), "Solid waste shall be restricted to the smallest area feasible and compacted as densely as practical into cells."
7. Per 15A NCAC 13B .0566(4), "Adequate soil cover shall be applied monthly, or when the active area reaches one acre in size, whichever occurs first."
8. The facility operates a long narrow working face. Material atop the landfill is covered with soil.
9. It is recommended that the working face be maintained small and compact and that the adjacent area/working face is covered with soil accordingly.
10. Excavation, grading, and fill material side slopes shall not exceed three to one (3:1).
11. A ready supply of soil shall be available for cover material.
12. Ensure permanent edge of waste markers are installed.
13. The facility annual report (FAR) was received by the SWS, dated July 23, 2015. Estimated facility throughput for July 2014 through June 2015 is 93,600 yd³.
14. When the facility permit is renewed ensure that the annual disposal rate is increased accordingly.
15. The facility may inquire with the SWS to add a leaf compost operation. The facility would like to collect leaves and either produce compost or have the option to store the leaves until the material decomposes and add it to the landfill working face and/or use it for soil amendment at the landfill.
16. There was no indication of erosion or runoff.
17. Access roads are of all-weather construction.
18. The facility is secured by a locked gate.
19. The facility has a proper sign.
20. The PTO expiration date is November 29, 2015.
21. The permit renewal application should be submitted immediately. Contact Ed Mussler, Permitting Branch Head – SWS at 919-707-8281, regarding this issue.


