The Solid Waste Section (Section) has reviewed the *Phase 4 Hydrogeologic and Groundwater Quality Assessment Report* for Central Carolina Monofill Landfill Phases I and II submitted by Nautilus Geologic Consulting on October 24, 2014 (Doc ID 22167). Groundwater assessments performed at the site (Phase 1 through Phase 4) have proven the contaminate plume has been fully delineated and no further groundwater assessment is necessary. The Section approves the recommendations detailed in the report. The facility may begin developing corrective action options.
