**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

1. The permit and operations plan were reviewed. All documentation was available and presented in an orderly manner.
2. The Service Area for the facility is North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia, Georgia and Tennessee.
3. The signage at the facility entrance was reviewed and was according to permit.
4. The facility is permitted to receive Scrap Tires.
5. Arrangements have been made with the local fire department to provide fire fighting services.
6. The tire collection site is permitted to store, prior to processing, not more than 300,000 tires.
7. Stockpiles and storage areas have been arranged for processing and are being managed properly at this time.
8. No severe on site or off site sedimentation were noted during the inspection.
9. Dust control and windblown litter are being managed well.
10. The waste type was reviewed and is according to permit. Waste screening records are not required.
11. The financial assurance instrument must be reviews annually with verification to the Division Of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section by 15 August each year.
