Mr. Francis:

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has completed a review of the submittal titled *Francis Farm Landfill – Cap Maintenance Plan* (DIN 24050). The document was submitted on your behalf by McGill Associates and was received in the Asheville Regional Office on March 24, 2015.

The submittal includes numerous plan drawings detailing the work necessary to add soil to an approximate six acre area within the closed disposal unit to reduce the impacts of subsidence. Based on this review, the Section authorizes the landfill cap maintenance plan in accordance with the plans as submitted. However, given the impacts to the gas and leachate collection system, I request an engineer's certification, along with a final "as-built" drawing, be provided at the end of the project stating all work has been accomplished according to the plans and all systems are functioning as designed. Any significant changes to the submitted plan may require approval by the Section prior to implementation. There are no permit conditions associated with this activity so no permit modification will be required and no permit fee assessed.
