The item(s) listed above were observed by Section staff and require action on behalf of the facility in order to come into or maintain compliance with the Statutes, Rules, and/or other regulatory requirements applicable to this facility. Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. On site for comprehensive facility inspection with Mr. Gibson. Site access was controlled/gated and roads were in good condition.
2. Groundwater monitoring records are kept at the courthouse. The two most recent groundwater monitoring events records are on file with the Section. Two monitoring wells (MW-1 and MW-2) are part of the approved groundwater monitoring network. Wells were accessible and labeled.
3. The previous inspection report outlined the following:
While the edge of waste was not clearly defined, it appeared as though some small trees had taken root on the cap. This landfill was closed under the .0500 Rules and the Post-Closure General Condition #4 states that: the integrity and effectiveness of the final cover system and any permanent erosion control devices must be maintained. This could include making repairs to the cover as necessary to correct the effects of settlement, subsidence, erosion, or other events.

These two issues were discussed on site with Mr. Gibson. Please contact the Section when the repairs are complete and EOW markers are in place.

4. In general the cap was in good condition. No erosion was noted. Please continue to ensure that no woody trees/shrubs are allowed to take root on the cap system.
5. The previous inspection report (1/27/2010) requested documentation to the Section regarding the landfill compliance with 15A NCAC 13B .0503 (2)(a). Please review this report and contact the Section to discuss possible options.
