On July 22, 2014 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Henderson County's request, entitled;

Notification of Henderson County Solid Waste Universal Waste Handling Permit Additions. Prepared by Henderson County Engineering. July 2014. DIN 21476.

The request concerns the County's Plan to accept mercury-containing devices and lamps containing mercury at the Transfer Facility, Permit No. 4504T-TRANSFER-1998.

The Section has reviewed the Plan and approves the immediate implementation of the Plan. Henderson County shall consider the referenced Plan (DIN 21476) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in this manner until the current permit is either amended or modified. The next time the Facility prepares either a Permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit a complete revised Operations Plan which includes the mercury products recycling plan.
