Dear Mr. Proctor:

Please find enclosed the Permit to Construct and Operate for the Johnston County MSW and C&D Landfill, Permit No. 51-03. This permit approves the Permit to Construct for C&D Area 2, Cell 2, and also approves the five year renewal for the existing MSW and C&D landfill units.

For the permit renewal, changes were made to the groundwater monitoring plan, to consolidate the previous different monitoring networks (MSW, C&D, Phase 5) into one network. Also, the property boundary was increased to include the yard waste management area and additional buffer area east of C&D Area 2, and all separate landfill parcels were combined to one landfill parcel.

In general, the new facility permit does not reiterate permit conditions which are included in the Solid Waste Management Rules, 15A NCAC 13B, nor does it restate specific conditions which are included within the approved plans, such as site specific operations. Please review the conditions of the permit carefully.

Of particular note is condition #3 on page 2 that requires recordation of the permit at the Register of Deeds within 30 days, and return of the recorded permit to the Solid Waste Section. The certified copy of the permit for recordation purposes is enclosed.

Also, permit condition #9 on page 8 lists the preoperative conditions for C&D Area 2, Cell 2, including the installation of a new groundwater well and new landfill gas monitoring wells.
