STATUS OF PERMIT:

Active; Permit to Operate Landfill 3 Phases 2, 3, and 4 issued 4 October 2013. This permit expires 22 May 2018. Pursuant to 15A NCAC 13B .0201(g) a complete permit review request including updated facility, operations, and waste screening plans is due on or before 22 November 2017. This application must comply with the rules and regulations in effect at the time of the application.

STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS:

OBSERVED VIOLATIONS:

No violations were observed during this Facility Compliance Inspection. Please see the ADDITIONAL COMMENTS section below.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

- 1) This facility is permitted to receive solid waste generated by and on the property of Domtar Paper Company, LLC located off of Ken Trowbridge Road, Plymouth, North Carolina.
- 2) This facility is recorded with the Washington County Register of Deeds at: Book 443; Page 595.
- 3) This Facility is currently landfilling +/-125 tons of waste per month.
- 4) Leachate is collected and treated on-site.
- 5) Landfill gas monitoring is not required under the current PTO.
- 6) The landfill supervisor conducts routine maintenance inspections of the Facility on average of three times per week and after every storm event. These inspections are recorded in a log which was in order and presented for review during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
- 7) This Facility screens all wastes received for unpermitted materials with three screenings per week documented in the waste screening log. This log was in order and presented for review during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
- 8) The Facility leachate collection and management system is being inspected as required. All leachate collection system

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monitoring and maintenance activities are recorded in a dated log which is maintained in the Facility Supervisor's office.

- 9) The leachate system inspection log was in order and presented for review during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
- 10) The leachate collection system is inspected internally bi-annually through pipeline video inspection and is cleaned through power jetting as needed. All internal leachate system inspection and line jetting is conducted by Jetclean America, LLC of Odessa, FL. The Jetclean America Leachate System Inspection Report was in order and presented for review during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
- 11) Leachate is collected and treated on-site.
- 12) Leachate sampling is being conducted semi-annually.
- 13) The leachate collection system cleanouts are highly visible, accessible, protected, and well maintained.
- 14) The Facility access road is of all-weather construction and is being well maintained at this time.
- 15) The stormwater/sedimentation control basins were clear of vegetation and appear well maintained.
- 16) Highly visible edge-of-liner stakes are being maintained throughout the Facility.
- 17) This landfill is currently operating in Unit III cell 2. Unit II Cell 1 has been closed and covered.



- 18) A cover crop of native warm season grasses has been well established and maintained on the closed areas of the landfill.



- 19) The Facility cover crop is mowed semi-annually.
- 20) The surface water drainage features are well maintained, in good working order, and appear to be functioning properly.

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- 21) Phases 3 and 4 of the Landfill are currently being used for staging and processing ash from the Domtar plant which is removed from the site for use as an agricultural soil amendment.



- 22) The waste type in the landfill was reviewed; no unpermitted wastes were noted at the working face during this Facility Compliance Inspection.



- 23) The working face is being maintained in a compact and manageable size.
24) Windblown debris is being well managed. Windblown debris was minimal and no windblown litter was observed leaving the Facility during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
25) Soil and ash are being stockpiled adjacent to the working face for daily cover.
26) No off-site erosion was observed during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
27) No violations were observed during this Facility Compliance Inspection.
