Thank you for helping to answer my questions regarding the reporting deadlines.

The Watauga County Landfill completed their second semiannual monitoring event on September 2, 2014; therefore, the GW and SW monitoring report is due January 1, 2015 (120 days from the event). We have encountered some minor delays related to analytical data and would like to request an extension until January 30, 2015 to submit the report.
