RE: Modification of Transfer Station Permit No: 96-07T

Dear Ms. Backus:

This letter is to act as an official request to modify the operation permit (revised August 2011) for the City of Goldsboro Transfer Station, located at 904 Brick Street, Goldsboro, Wayne County, North Carolina.

We request that this facility be permitted to receive recycling material generated throughout Wayne County which includes: all municipalities, town or county offices, schools; as well as, City of Kinston located in Lenoir County.

This facility utilizes direct dumping into a compactor; meaning the recycle material is pushed into a closed top transfer trailer by a ram compactor. Compactor hoppers are used for compacting and loading the transfer trailers; no recycle material will be stored in an open area. Once the trailer has been filled, we carry it to an approved recycling facility contracted by the City of Goldsboro. We currently are taking the trailers to Pratt Industries, 3680 Owen Drive, Fayetteville, NC; which is approximately 65 miles away from our facility. Recyclables can be stored in transfer trailers at the facility with the doors closed after operating hours but no longer than 72 hours.

The City of Goldsboro currently generates approximately 107 tons of recyclables per month, the City of Kinston approximately 52 tons per month and the other remaining county and municipalities combined are approximately 45 tons per month. We do not have a scale house at our facility; however, weight tickets will be received from Pratt Industries and given to each user so the totals can be documented in their monthly reports.

Lastly, we utilize 5 transfer trailers and 2 load tractors and our transfer station facility is operated by city employees that are certified Transfer Station Operational Specialists.
