The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received a request for a five-year renewal of the Permit to Operate at the Louisiana-Pacific Industrial Landfill (DIN 21449). The document was received in the Asheville Regional Office on July 21, 2014.

The submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee has been paid and all the components required by 15A NCAC 13B. 0504 have been submitted so the application is deemed **complete**.
