This firm is counsel to ReUse Technology, Inc. ("ReUse"). ReUse has exchanged extensive correspondence with the Division of Waste Management commencing November 11, 1991 regarding the construction and closure of a coal combustion by-product structural fill facility in Nash County on U.S. Highway 301 at Swift Creek, Battleboro, North Carolina.

Please take notice that ReUse has agreed to a sale of all of its business and assets, including the Swift Creek coal combustion byproduct structural fill property discussed in the above correspondence, to Full Circle Solutions, Inc.
