Dear Mr. Newbern.:

On February 12, 2014, you were issued Notice of Violation indicating that you and Green Acres Land Development and Ready Mix were in violation of 15A North Carolina Administrative Code .0566 (3)(4)&(7).

A follow-up inspection of the Green Acres Land Development and Ready Mix on August 21, 2014, indicated that the violations outlined in the Notice have still not been corrected.

Because the violations were not corrected on or before the deadline for compliance, which was April 30, 2014, this matter is being referred to the Section Chief of the Division of Waste Management's Solid Waste Section, for enforcement. I urge you to correct these violations immediately. Pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22(a) and 15A NCAC 13B .0701-.0707, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000.00 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or an Order issued under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. It should be noted that each day of noncompliance constitutes a separate violation. A penalty may be assessed from the date of the violation until the date the violations are corrected. Please be advised that if compliance is not immediately undertaken, other appropriate action may be requested.
