ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. The Septage Land Application Site consist of 2 fields:
Field No. 1- 2.4 acres and Field No. 2 - 1.2 acres.
2. The site is permitted for fescue as vegetative cover.
3. Both Field 1 and Field 2 have good fescue vegetative cover. There are several areas on Field 1 which contains weeds, Mr. Lawson is to conduct fall seeding of fescue in September/October.
4. Recent septage applications on both fields observed to be well spread with no pooling or dense areas.
5. Hay has been harvested from the site as per approved nutrient management plans.
6. The site has accessible all-weather roads.
7. Appropriate signage in place as per requirements.
8. Disposal area boundaries clearly delineated with permanent markers.
9. Buffer areas noted to exceed requirements to residences (500 ft.) and property lines (50 ft.)
10. The site has an approved above ground septage detention system (Permit SDTF 85-06). No spillage observed around detention system.
11. Total maximum application rate for the two fields is 50,000 gallons per acre per year or 175,500 gallons per year, total.
12. The site appears to be well maintained.
