**STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS:**

On 11/14/13 an observed violation to Rule .0838(a)(18) was noted for a crop being planted in the fields that was not in the nutrient management plan. The nutrient management plan had grain sorghum listed as the crop and soybeans were present on the fields. The nutrient management plan was updated to reflect a crop rotation of soybeans and wheat on 11/27/13.

**OBSERVED VIOLATIONS:**

6. Soybeans present on the fields. Excellent stand of soybeans present.
7. pH not checked. No application at time of inspection.
8. No objectionable odors noticed today.
9. No issues noticed with any of the setbacks.
10. Records being reviewed as a part of permit renewal.
11. No violations noted today.
