The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) has received your submittal titled *MSW Transfer Station Permit Application Package* (document ID number 24006). The document was submitted on your behalf by Brooks Engineering Associates and was received in the Asheville Regional Office on March 12, 2015.

The submittal has been reviewed for completeness in accordance with General Statute 130A-295.8(e). A determination of completeness means that the application includes all required components but does not mean the required components provide all of the information that is required for the Section to make a decision on the application. The permitting activity fee has been paid and most of the components required by 15A NCAC 13B.0301 have been submitted. However, the required zoning approval letter from the local government was not part of the application. As a result, the application is deemed **incomplete**.

In order to complete the application, please submit a letter from the local government indicating the proposed facility meets all of the requirements of the local zoning ordinance.
