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**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

1. The facility utilizes an old concrete pad from a previously demolished building to store the waste.
2. This facility will stockpile clean wood, small limbs, stumps and tree leaves not to exceed 6000 tons per quarter. The pile was approaching 6K cubic yards at the time of this inspection.
3. The waste will be ground up and hauled to McGill Environmental not less than monthly site staff.
4. McGill will compost the material and there will be no further handling by city staff.
5. The pile was approaching one acre in size at the time of this inspection.
6. There was a small amount of unacceptable waste observed in the waste. Unacceptable waste should be removed before dumping or once it is observed.
