Dear Mr. Cannon,

The Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section, received your closure letter stating you have chosen to no longer use your Yard Waste Site located on US-64W in Mills River, NC. Your records were removed from our list of active yard waste facilities on May 13, 2012. Please keep this letter on file for future reference.

You are hereby advised that, pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Statute or Regulations. For the violation(s) noted here, you may be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

If at any time you wish to resume operation of a yard waste facility, you must contact our office for the proper forms. Should you have questions or if we may be of further assistance, please contact our office at 919-707-8285.
