On December 22, 2015 the Division of Waste Management, Solid Waste Section (Section) received Duke Energy's request, entitled;

Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, Marshall Steam Station Retired Ash Landfill (INDUS_1804), Marshall Landfill Vegetation Maintenance Plan. Prepared for Duke Energy. Prepared by AECOM. December 2015. DIN 25492.

The request concerns Duke Energy's proposal to management the vegetation on the closed Permit No. 1804-INDUS-1983 landfill at the Marshall Steam Station (Facility).

The Section has reviewed the request and hereby approves the immediate implementation of the proposal at the Facility. Duke Energy shall consider the referenced request (DIN 25492) as an approved document. The Facility should operate in accordance with the plan until the current Facility permit is either amended or modified. Therefore, the next time the Facility prepares either a permit amendment or modification it is expected to submit an updated operations plan which includes the vegetation management plan for closed Permit No. 1804-INDUS-1983 landfill.
