Dear Mr. Frost,

On October 19, 2015, Duke Energy (Duke) notified the Division that the final placement of coal combustion product occurred at the Marshall Steam Station FGD Landfill (Permit No. 1804-INDUS). With that notification, Duke requested deference of closure activities. In a response from the Division dated October 20, 2015, Duke received approval to defer closure activities.

This letter serves as response to the Division expectations as follows:

1. Apply a minimum of one foot (12 inches) of intermediate soil cover to all areas of the landfill.

Response: Intermediate soil placement was completed on 11/18/2015.

2. Within six (6) months utilize temporary seeding to stabilize all areas of the landfill.

Response: A mixture of permanent and temporary seeding has been applied and stabilized with Hydromulch, Duke will notify the Division on vegetative condition within 6 months.

3. Notify the Section when each activity (above) is completed.

Response: This letter serves as notification for items completed to date.

4. Notify the Section of the Facility's determination, whether to expand the landfill or enter into closure, but October 1, 2016.

Response: This letter serves as notification for items completed to date. Duke will notify the Division of landfill status by October 1, 2016.

5. And prior to implementing final closure the Facility will submit, for Section approval, a revised closure plan.

Response: Duke understands that a revised closure plan will need to be submitted to and approved by the Division prior to implementing closure activities.

Duke Energy is committed to environmental stewardship and cooperation with the Division regarding the operation, maintenance, safety, and integrity of all of its facilities. We look forward to continuing to work with you regarding the operation/closure of this facility.
