Dear Mr. Hester:

You are in arrears in the amount of \$750 in Annual Permit Fees for fiscal year 2013/2014 for the River City Transfer Station. In addition, you have not paid the requisite \$3,000 for your 5-year Permit Amendment Fee for the application you submitted February 26, 2013.

In order for this agency to process your permit renewal application, you must submit payment by cashier's check or cash to this office totaling \$3,750 by the close of business on March 14, 2014.

Should your payment not be received by that date, your February 26, 2013 application will no longer be viable and your permit will expire. You will no longer have authorization to operate your facility, and should you continue to operate beyond that date, you will be in violation of the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act (North Carolina General Statute 130A), and its Rules found in 15A North Carolina Administrative Code 13B.
