Operation plan:

1. Construct and maintain proposed and existing erosion control measures
2. Pave first 150' of entrance drive off of Scalesville Road
3. Begin filling landfill with material allowed (uncontaminated) soil, rock, concrete, stumps, brush, untreated wood and asphalt
4. Apply adequate soil cover when active area reaches one acre in size and seed the area
Per Rule .0565(4)
 - a. Mark B. Doggett

 - b. Pasture or reforest
 - c. To conduct usage of the disposal area in an organized system including shaping of the disposal area on a regular basis, when proposed parameters are met a soil cover will be dispersed over the disposal area and will be seeded according to County and State specifications.
 - d.
 1. Type of material accepted: uncontaminated soil, rock concrete, stumps, brush, untreated wood and asphalt
 2. Source of debris will be from various job sites in Guilford, Forsyth and Rockingham Counties that erosion control permits are issued for, that state that debris is to be disposed of in a permitted LCID, and hours of operation will be from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday
 3. To conduct passive composting within the permitted area
 4. To designate a portion of the permitted area as a TDDSS following the guidelines of the Emergency/Disaster Vegetative and Land Clearing Debris Guidance found on the Solid Waste Section Portal
 5. Quantity of material to be accepted to be as defined by the proposed topographic plan

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- e. Per Doggett Construction Company, Inc., correspondence with the Summerfield Fire Department; Doggett Construction, Co. Inc. will provide necessary equipment and fill material required to work in tandem with the Fire Department
- 5. Control access to the area by means of a locked gate
- 6. Provide and maintain adequate all-weather access roads
- 7. Prevent water from standing on the fill area
- 8. Open burning will not be permitted
- 9. A sign will be erected at the entrance showing contact name and number and permit number
- 10. No dumping will be permitted to the public
