MATERIALS BURNING / BURNT
House hold trash in dumpster at recycling center. Area dumpster was marked for desposing of house hold trash.

ACTION TAKEN
Fire department arrived on scene and found a dumpster on fire. Fire department put dumpster out and said that it had been burning for a while because they was a lot of smoldering ashes left in dumpster. They found very little fire and heavy smoke because material was burnt up and heavy ashes left in bottom of dumpster. Something possibly put in trash to cause fire accidently.

NOTES / COMMENTS
Fire department had to cut lock to gain access into driveway that leads to area of dumpsters. Cause of ignition looks unintentional. Paint burnt off dumpster and all material still contained in dumpster.
