Enclosed you will find a copy of Permit No. 5503, dated February 12, 2016 (DIN 25607), for the construction of Phase 4 of your MSWLF facility. The Permit to Operate ensures the continued operation of your existing facility. The following are important items that remain to be accomplished;

- Read your permit carefully, it is important that you understand your permit. If you have any questions regarding the permit contact me immediately.
- The approved documents related to this permit may be downloaded at <http://portal.ncdenr.org/web/wm/sw>, Document Tracker.
- Copies of this permit, the approved plans, and all records, are required to be maintained by the permittee at the facility, and made available to the Section upon request during normal business hours.
- Be aware that you must request permit renewal for both the MSW and C&D landfills on or before March 12, 2016 and provide at a minimum a revised/updated operations plan for the C&D landfill and miscellaneous activities.
- The Solid Waste Section has no record of any permit ever being recorded by this Facility, therefore I have included a certified copy of the permit for recordation. Be aware of Attachment 1, condition number 3, which states;

*The permit shall not be effective until the certified copy of this permit which shows current ownership and references legal descriptions for all land within the solid waste management facility boundary is recorded in the Register of Deeds office and indexed in the grantor index under the name of the owner of the land in the county or counties in which the land is located. The certified copy of the permit affixed with the Register's seal and the date, book, and page number of recording must be returned to the Section within 30 calendar days of issuance of this permit. If the Section does not receive the certified copy of the recorded permit within 30 calendar days of issuance of the permit, then and in that event, the permit is suspended and of no effect until the date the Section receives the certified copy of the recorded permit.*
