PURPOSE OF SITE VISIT:

Comprehensive inspection to ensure that the Structural Fill Facility is in compliance with 15A North Carolina Administration Code (NCAC) 13B. 1700, “Requirements For Beneficial Use Of Coal Combustion By-Products.”

STATUS OF PAST NOTED VIOLATIONS:

OBSERVED VIOLATIONS

The item(s) listed above were observed by Section staff and require action on behalf of the facility in order to come into or maintain compliance with the Statutes, Rules, and/or other regulatory requirements applicable to this facility. Be advised that pursuant to N.C.G.S. 130A-22, an administrative penalty of up to \$15,000 per day may be assessed for each violation of the Solid Waste Laws, Regulations, Conditions of a Permit, or Order under Article 9 of Chapter 130A of the N.C. General Statutes. Further, the facility and/or all responsible parties may also be subject to enforcement actions including penalties, injunction from operation of a solid waste management facility or a solid waste collection service and any such further relief as may be necessary to achieve compliance with the North Carolina Solid Waste Management Act and Rules.

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ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

1. B.B. Pierce was the owner of the property at the time of the construction of the structural fill project which was completed in late 1998. The property is located in Weldon, NC on and is located on Hwy 158 at the end of Sycamore St. According to the Halifax County Tax Assessor it is identified as Parcel # 1200156.
2. Approximately 122,498 cubic yards of coal combustion products were utilized in the construction of the structural fill. The structural fill operation was performed by The Plumblin Corp. The coal combustion products were generated by the Westmorland Roanoke Valley Energy Facility.
3. The notification dated June 9, 1997 indicated that the structural fill would be used to make the site suitable to build a materials testing laboratory. As of the time of the inspection, the site was undeveloped.
4. The site was recorded by the property owner, B.B. Pierce., with the Halifax County Register of Deeds on November 24, 1998. The recordation can be found in Book 1770, Page 456.
5. The facility shall be covered with a minimum of 12-inches compacted earth and an additional 6-inches of surface soil capable of supporting native vegetation as per 15A NCAC 13B .1705(j). Visible ash was not observed during the inspection. The site appeared well vegetated.
6. No ponded water was observed during the inspection. As a reminder per 15A NCAC 13B .1706(b) The final surface of the structural fill shall be graded and provided with drainage systems that:...(2) Promote drainage of area precipitation, minimize infiltration and prevent ponding of surface water on the structural fill. Depressions collecting storm water on the structural fill should be regraded or filled to promote drainage and prevent ponding.
