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**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

1. All photographs were taken by Troy Harrison on November 16, 2015.
2. The Septage Land Application Site consists of one field 1 of 7.5 usable acres.
3. The site is permitted for land application of domestic septage.
4. The site had accessible all-weather road to the septage land application field covered under the permit.
5. Appropriate signage was displayed at the site.
6. All fields had disposal area boundaries that were well delineated with permanent markers (fence) which corresponded to the site map.



7. All septage discharges appear to have been made within the disposal area boundary. The waste appeared to be evenly distributed throughout the field. No recent septage application were observed.
8. No evidence of standing liquid or pooled waste was observed.
9. No objectionable odors were observed.
10. The nutrient management plan appears to have been followed.
11. Site logs were not reviewed at this time.
12. Soil samples were collected from the field. The check for soil sampling was received.
