Hwy 903 in Halifax County**

Dear Mr. Minks and Ms. Phillips:

The NC Division of Waste Management has closed out permit, **SLAS-42-08**, issued to you under Chantilly Septic Tank Service for the operation of a septage land application site in Halifax County off of Hwy 903. This site is being closed due to an incomplete application for permit renewal. A final inspection was conducted on November 6, 2014.

The last soil analysis, dated January 21, 2015, indicated that no lime was required for the present crop, thus meeting the requirements of Septage Management Rule .0843 (e) for site closure.

As of this date, permit #SLAS-42-08 is effectively closed. No septage land application may occur in the future at this location without a valid and current permit. No new septage permit may be issued to you until the Compliance Order with Administrative Penalty issued on July 23, 2014 has been resolved, with all of the terms and conditions of that Order met. The use of this septage land application site, that is no longer permitted, may result in administrative penalties up to \$15,000 per violation in accordance with NC General Statute 130A-22.
